### TPG acquires Siemens Gemsa's India and Sri Lanka businesses

TPG, a global alternative asset management firm, has acquired a 90% stake in Siemens Gamesa's onshore wind turbine businesses in India and Sri Lanka. The deal includes the transfer of approx. 1,000 employees and existing manufacturing infrastructure, with Siemens Gamesa retaining a 10% stake (Mercom)

### Adani New Industries incorporates subsidiary for solar manufacturing

Coal India Limited (CIL) and GAIL (India) Limited have formed a joint venture, Coal Gas India Limited, to establish a coal-to-synthetic natural gas project in West Bengal. CIL holds a 51% stake, while GAIL owns 49% (Mercom)

#### CIL and GAIL form JVC for coal to SNG project

CIL and GAIL (India) Limited have formed a joint venture company, Coal Gas India Limited, to develop a coal-to-SNG project in Eastern Coalfields, West Bengal. The venture aims to produce SNG and other products from coal gasification, with CIL holding a 51% stake and GAIL 49% (Powerline)

### Waaree Energies secures 255 MW DC solar EPC and O&M order

Waaree Renewable Technologies Limited (WRTL) has secured a ₹232.3 crore EPC and O&M contract from its promoter, Waaree Energies Limited, for a 170 MW AC (255 MW DC) ground-mount solar project. The project is scheduled for completion in the financial year 2025-26 (Powerline)

## **K2** Infragen secures solar EPC order from KPI Green Energy in Gujarat

K2 Infragen has secured a solar EPC contract from KPI Green Energy Limited for a 67.61 MW project in Khavda, Gujarat, part of Coal India Limited's 450 MWp solar development under Gujarat Urja Vikas Nigam Limited (Powerline)

### REIAs justify charging trading margin, want issue settled with discoms

REIAs are defending a ₹0.07/kWh trading margin charged to DISCOMs, emphasizing its role in covering procurement and risk mitigation costs. They highlight that this margin accounts for less than 3% of current solar tariffs, which are approximately ₹2.50/kWh (Mercom)

#### **Regulatory Update**

### MERC approves ₹2.19 Lakh/MW tariff for MSEDCL's BESS Project

The MERC has approved a tariff of ₹2,19,001 per megawatt per month for Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Co. Ltd.'s (MSEDCL) 1.5 GWh Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) project. This tariff applies to the procurement of 250 MW/500 MWh base capacity, with an additional green shoe option for up to 500 MW/1,000 MWh (SaurEnergy)

## Government removes coal purchase restriction to boost energy

The Indian government has lifted restrictions on coal purchases for thermal power plants, allowing them to procure coal beyond their annual contracted quantities. This move aims to enhance energy security and support growing power demands (LegalitySimplified)

#### US oil producers face new challenges as top oilfield flags
